The meeting was opened with members reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the May 4, 2015 regular meeting was provided to each Council member prior to the meeting and approved as written.

Mr. Leis made a motion to pay M&W Trailers \$185.69 second by Mr. Moreno. Vote: Vote: Altenburger, yes; Leis, yes; Byrne, yes, Hoersten, yes; & Moreno, yes. Markward abstains.

Mr. Byrne moved to change estimated resources & appropriations and add \$3,000.00 to the State Highway Fund to pay for materials to repair SR66 South. Mrs. Hoersten seconds this motion. Vote: Altenburger, yes; Markward, yes; Leis, yes; Byrne, yes, Hoersten, yes; & Moreno, yes.

Mayor Miller informed council that the Village (Mayor, streets, utilities) met with Choice One Engineers for planning of the Bendele Street Storm Improvements. The engineers are in contact with the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) to see if we can move the completion date for this project to next spring. This will give the Village a better chance to get lower quotes since contractors are extremely busy right now. The OPWC is funding this project with a grant and a no interest loan The bid opening for this project is scheduled for June 17, 2015. The Village has also discussed including an upgrade on the waterline on Sixth Street from a 4 inch to a 6 inch in this project. Mr. Byrne moved to approve these plans and bid this project on June 17, 2015 at 10am, second by Mr. Markward. The Village Solicitor notified council that she will be meeting with Mr. Kevin Connell (attorney) & Jeff Basinger Celedon Trucking and Main Street Market owners to discuss options on the Dollar Street issue. Mayor Miller & Councilman Altenburger were also requested to join the meeting which will be held June 1st. Results will be brought to the June 22nd Village council meeting for approval.

Mr. Byrne requested the street department address a sink hole on Second Street next to the Day Care parking lot. Barry will place a cone on the hole until repairs can be made.

Board of Public Affairs President Phil Hilvers reported from the board meeting:

- o Dollar Street has 170' of sewer main & a clean out at the east end. Easement would be needed if this street is vacated.
- o Adkins Sanitation is finished videotaping the sanitary sewer lines. Council requested the Board have Choice One engineers evaluate these tapes for repair suggestions.
- The Board signed a one year contract with Haviland Energy for sludge hauling.
- o Board was requested to take another flow meter reading in the Auglaize Street sewer line after all sump pumps are removed from this line to check for changes.
