Minutes of the August 24, 2015 regular meeting & September 17, 2015 special meeting were provided to each Council member prior to the meeting and approved as written.

Mr. Leis made a motion to approve bills presented for payment (see register attached), second by Mr. Byrne. Vote: Altenburger, yes; Markward, yes; Leis, yes; Byrne, yes; & Moreno, yes.

First reading Ordinance 2015-03, Jacqueline Schimmoeller annexation 8.897 acreas.

Mr. Markward made a motion to reaffirm the Village contract with Public Entities Pool for property and liability insurance with Thomas Welsh as the Village insurance agent. Mr. Moreno seconds this motion. Vote: Markward, yes; Leis, yes; Byrne, yes; & Moreno, yes. Altenburger abstains.

Jonathan Fortman of Fortman Insurance was present to discuss the upcoming health insurance renewal.

Miller Contracting Group was contacted about digging up Auglaize Street waterline. They stated they are available the week of October 12th. Council will be notified which day this will happen.

Mayor Miller gave an update on the SR189 culvert project.

The trucking company on Dollar Street has not replied to communications concerning the street. They will be contacted again.

Board of Public Affairs members Phil Hilvers & Dan Honigford reported from the board meeting:

Council was informed that the Village applied for the Issue II OPWC grant monies for the SR66/Otto Street waterline loop.

Two quotes to replace the 4" water line with a 6" on E. Sixth St. from Otto Street to Gilbert Lane were received. Hohenbrink Contracting \$37,985.00 & J&M Excavating \$38,850.00. The Board recommended Council accept Hohenbrink's quote and purchase all parts quoted price of \$15,500.00.

O Board discussed the ditch for the Bendele Storm project & Bendele Triangle Phase II.
O Removing sump pumps from the sanitary was discussed.

Chief Honigford informed council that Looser Shell will no longer be selling diesel fuel. He contacted Monterey Township about the possibility of fueling the fire trucks from the township tanks. This will be discussed at the township meeting.

Mr. Leis reported of a complaint about four wheelers & dirt bikes entering the Village through the cemetery. He also noted a resident requested a speed bump put in the alley beside
