 - o Refurbish Van quote being obtained
 - o Truck 112 compartments, lights, pump control
 - quotes will be obtained
 - 5 year refurbish possibly starting in 2026
- Mr. Wannemacher made a motion to approve new fireman Cory Justice seconded by Mr. Moreno. A vote of six yeses passed this motion.
