# **SECTION I - Project Description**

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the described project:

This project proposes to mill and pave asphalt on the following State Routes:

- On US 224 in Putnam County from the bridge 0.1 mile west of Auglaize Street in the Village of Ottoville to the east corporation limits of the Village of Ottoville.
- On SR 114 in Paulding County from the west corporation limits to the east corporation limits of the Village of Grover Hill.
- On SR 637 in Paulding County from the Van Wert County Line to the south corporation limits of the Village of Grover Hill.
- On SR 637 in Paulding County from the north corporation limits of the Village of Grover Hill to SR613.

Curb ramp/sidewalk work will occur on US 224 in the Village of Ottoville and on SR 114 in the Village of Grover Hill.

WHEREAS, a portion of the described project is within the Village corporation limits.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Ottoville of Putnam County, Ohio.

### SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

### **SECTION III - Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

ODOT and FHWA shall assume and bear 100% of the necessary costs of the State's highway improvement project. In the event that the Village requests certain features or appurtenances to be included within the State's highway improvement project's design and construction, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State to be not necessary for the State's project, the Village shall contribute 100% of the cost of those items.

# SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required (if applicable) for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodations, relocations and reimbursements will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

### **SECTION V - Maintenance**

Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

# The Mayor of said Village of Ottoville is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Ottoville to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project. Passed: 8-24, 20-20.
