

**VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-04**

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY AND RESERVING AN EASEMENT IN  
THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ottoville believes there is good cause for vacating the south half of an alley running north and south between Third Street and Fourth Street and more completely described on attached Exhibit "A" in the Village of Ottoville; and

WHEREAS, there is good cause for said vacation and it will not be detrimental to the general interest of the residents of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottoville wishes to reserve an easement for utilities across the area.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, or two-thirds (2/3) concurring thereto:

SECTION 1. There is good cause for vacating the south half of an alley running north and south between Third Street and Fourth Street and more completely described on attached Exhibit "A" in the Village of Ottoville.

SECTION 2. Said vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest of the residents of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio.

SECTION 3. The south half of an alley running north and south between Third Street and Fourth Street and more completely described on attached Exhibit "A" in the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio is hereby vacated.

SECTION 4. The Village of Ottoville hereby reserves an easement for utilities across the area.


SECTION 5. The Fiscal Officer is directed to notify the Auditor of Putnam County of the vacation of said alley by certifying a copy of this ordinance to the Auditor as well as to notify all adjacent property owners of the vacation.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective at the earliest time allowable under the law.
