ORDINANCE NO. 2026-04

AN ORDINANCE FOR NAMING CERTAIN STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, PUTNAM COUNTY OHIO

WHEREAS, several parcels of land were annexed into the Village of Ottoville; and

WHEREAS, road P-25 was also annexed into the Village of Ottoville; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Council to name that part of Road P-25 which runs north and south as Big Green Lane and that part of Road P-25 which runs east and west Park View Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottoville Council and the Mayor have discussed this matter in meetings open to the public and have unanimously acclaimed the naming of Park View Drive and Big Green Lane appropriate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, a majority of its members elected thereto concurring.

SECTION 1. That portion of Road P-25 which runs north and south adjacent to and along the west side of the 8.368 acre parcel recently annexed into the Village of Ottoville, and as shown in the annexation plat attached, shall be renamed to Big Green Lane.

SECTION 2. That portion of Road P-25 which runs east and west adjacent to and along the north side of the 8.368 acre parcel recently annexed into the Village of Ottoville, and as shown in the annexation plat attached, shall be renamed to Park View Drive.

SECTION 3. That the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to share a certified copy of this ordinance with the Putnam County Engineer in order to allow this change to be reflected in the County GIS and EMA records.

SECTION 4. All utility easements, right-a-ways and any and all other existing licenses concerning sewers, waterlines, conduits and pipelines of all kinds owned and operated by the Village of Ottoville or other public utility shall be reserved to the Village and other utility companies with the rights of repair, construction and or replacement and maintenance.

SECTION 5. The street department shall erect signs indicating the names of the respective streets.

SECTION 6. That a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be recorded with the Recorder of Putnam County, Ohio.

SECTION 7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that

all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance shall be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
