ORDINANCE 9

EMPOWERING THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE PUTNAM COUNTY OHIO TO MAKE CERTAIN CONTRACT LEVY TAX AND BORROW MONEY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES THEREIN NAMED. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO

SECTION 1 That the council of said village be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to contract with lowest responsible bidder or bidders for the purpose of a village lot and for the erection there on of a suitable building or buildings for a village prison and engine house also the purchase of a hand fire engine, hose and fixtures for the use of said village.

SECTION 2 That to provide for the liquidation of any indebtedness incurred by reason of any such contract being entered into as provided in Section 1 of this Ordinance said council are hereby authorized and empowered to levy tax upon the taxable property of said Village to borrow money upon the credit of said corporation and to issue notes bonds of said corporation therefore in anticipation of the general revenue fund to be derived from the taxation of the taxable property of said village for the purpose not to exceed the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) said bonds to be of the denomination of five hundred dollars each to bear interest at the of six percent per anum payable semiannually five hundred dollars to mature July 1 A.D. 1896 and five hundred dollars to mature July 1 A.D. 1898 payable the Ottawa Exchange Bank Ottawa, Ohio. Said bonds to be disposed of the purpose a foresaid but not for a less sum nor to bear a greater rate of interest nor to run a longer period of tie nor to be redeemable within a shorter period of time than is now provided by law.

SECTION 3 That before any such contracts of shall be entered into said council shall give notice by posting five notices in the most public places of said village stating the time and place of letting such contract and the nature and object of the same for at least three weeks prior to the letting of any such contract

SECTION 4 That the mode of accessioning the lowest bidder or bidders as foresaid shall be sealed proposals for the furnishing of material and erecting of such building or buildings to be deposited in the Mayors Office of said village before a day to be named in said notice said council reserving to themselves the right to reject any or all such proposals

SECTION 5 That all such contracts where entered into shall be in writing duly signed by the party or parties undertaking the erection of such building or buildings on their part and the Mayor of said village upon behalf of said corporation be attested the clerk of said village it be further provided that any person or persons undertaking the erection of said building or buildings under such contract shall forthwith execute and deliver to said village authorities a good and sufficient bond for double the amount for

which said contracts may be let with two or more sufficient sureties to acceptance of said council conditioned for the faithful performance upon their part of any such contract.

SECTION 6 That plans and specifications of any such building or buildings so to be built shall be made out by said council and be posted in the Mayors office of said village to be opened for inspection of parties interested for at least ten day prior to the letting of any such contract.

SECTION 7 That a committee shall be appointed by said council at a meeting of the same whose duty it shall be to inspect the material used and work done upon any such building or buildings during the progress of the erection of the same and report to said council the kind of material used and work done on any such building or buildings in the erection of the same at each meeting of council during the progress of such erection.

SECTION 8 This ordinance to take effect and be in full force from and after the Sixteenth day of June A.D. 1891
