

ORDINANCE 17

TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPENSATION OF
CERTAIN OFFICERS THEREIN NAMED

Section 1 Be it ordained by the Council of the incorporated Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio, that the Marshall of said village shall be allowed for all services required of him by law the sum of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) yearly in addition to the fees otherwise provided for the law.

Section 2 That the mayor of said Village shall be allowed the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) yearly for all services required of him by law in addition to the fees otherwise provided for by law.

Section 3 The clerk of said village shall be allowed the sum of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) yearly for all services required of him by law.

Section 4 The street commissioner shall receive for all services rendered said village as street commissioner the same compensation as is allowed by law to township road supervisors.

Section 5 This ordinance is to take effect and be in full force from and after the 10 Th. day of May A. D. 1900.
