

ORDINANCE NO 48

TO VACATE WALNUT STREET, FROM A POINT IN WALNUT STREET, ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY FOUR (194) FEET SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF WALNUT AND SEVENTH STREETS TO THE END OF WALNUT STREET FACING OUTLOT NO. 10

WHEREAS, on the second (2nd.) day of May, 1932, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Walnut Street, from a point in Walnut Street, One Hundred and Ninety Four (194) Feet south of the intersection of Walnut and Seventh Streets, to the end of Walnut Street facing Outlot No. 10 was duly presented to Council, praying that said street between the points named be vacated.

Whereas, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, STATE OF OHIO,

Sec. 1.--That Walnut Street, from a point in Walnut Street, One Hundred and Ninety Four (194) Feet south of the intersection of Walnut and Seventh Streets, to the end of Walnut Street facing Outlot No. 10, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2.--That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
