ORDINANCE NO. 58  
(Section 1178-42, Ohio General Code)

GRANTING DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS AUTHORITY TO MAINTAIN  
CENTERLINES ON STATE HIGHWAYS INSIDE VILLAGE CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, The Director of Highways, under Sec. 1178-42 of the General Code of Ohio, is authorized to centerline paint extensions of State Highways within the limits of a village, and

WHEREAS, Extensions of State Highways No. 425-435-510 lie within this village, and

WHEREAS, This ordinance shall in no manner relieve or discharge the said village from any claim or claims of any nature arising from, or growing out of, the maintenance by the Department of Highways of the State of Ohio of said highways in said village, and the said village shall save the State of Ohio harmless from any and all such claims,

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: It is hereby declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said village be, and said consent hereby is, given to the Department of Highways of the State of Ohio for said Department to centerline paint the State Highways within said village as hereinbefore set out.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk be, and he hereby is, directed to furnish to the Director of Highways and to the Board of County Commissioners of Putman County, Ohio, a certified copy of this Ordinance immediately upon the taking effect thereof.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
