

ORDINANCE NO. 61

An Ordinance to regulate the Driving of Vehicles and Parking of such Vehicles within the limits of the Incorporated Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the incorporated Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio,

Sec. 1 - That the Speed Laws of the State of Ohio shall govern the various speed limits within the limits of the incorporated Village, to wit: thirty five ~~KETL~~ (35) miles per hour in the residential section; twenty five (25) miles in the business section; and twenty (20) miles per hour in the school zone.

Sec. 2 - Residential Section defined: Every street in the Village shall be ~~reecogni~~ classed as in the residential section except that portion of Route #224 beginning at Auglaize Street thence ~~on~~ Third Street till West Canal St; thence north on West Canal St. till Main St; thence east on Main St .till East Canal St. Also that part of Church Street between 2nd. & 3d. Streets.

Business Section defined: The Business Section shall include that part of ~~Route~~ # 224 which has been described in the exception cited above in the description of the Residential Section with further exception covered by the School Zone.

Schhol Zone defined: The School zone shall be designated as that part of Third St. lying between ~~State Route 66~~ *Auglaize St.* (also called Wayne St.) and West Canal St; also that part of Church Street lying between Second St. and Third St.

Section # 3 - Any person or persons violating any of the speed limits listed above in their respective sections shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty five (\$25.) dollars, nor less than Five (\$5.) dollars and costs of prosecution, and may be ordered to stand committed until such fine and costs are paid.

Section 4 - The Regulations governing the mode and manner of parking within the limits of said Village of Ottoville shall be in compliance with such markings as are now in evidence on Route # 224 and on Church Street, Viz: Parallel parking on both sides of Route # 224; and Parallel parking on the East side of Church St. and angle parking on the West side of Church Street

Section 5 - Parking at any and all places where yellow paint curb markings are in evidence is hereby forbidden.


Section 6 - Parking in or on all cross-walk zones is hereby forbidden

Section 7 - Double parking on any and all the streets of the village shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance and all convictions shall be duly punished.


Section 8 - Any person or persons violating any of the regulations laid down in Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 of the foregoing shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined one (1) dollar for each separate offense and the costs of prosecution and may be ordered to stand committed until such fine and costs are paid.

Section 9 - This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
