# ORDINANCE \# 66 

## TO VACATE STREET

WHEREAS, On the 5 th day of May, 1954, a petition by all the persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of a street beginning at the southeast corner of Inlet 116 and running thence northward between inlet 116 and outlet 1 , and between outlot 2 and the school lot, to the northwest corner of outlot 2 , was duly presented to council praying that said street between the points named be vacated, and also an alley adjacent to and running along the north side of inlots 116 and 117 be vacated.

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for said vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED By the Council of the Village of Ottoville:

Section 1. That a street beginning at the southeast corner of inlet 116 and running thence northward between inlot 116 and outlot 1 , and between outlot 2 and the school lot, to the northwest corner of outlot 2 , be and the same is hereby vacated, also an alley adjacent to and running along the north side of ingots 116 and 117 be vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
