

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for electric energy to operate the municipal Water Works system of said Village.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same.

SECTION 1:

That the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said Village be and are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for obtaining all the electric energy necessary to operate the entire municipal Water Works system of said Village, in accordance with specifications dated Feb. 6, 1956, which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said Village and which have been presented and read at this meeting, and which specifications are hereby approved and ordered to be identified by the presiding officer and clerk of this Council.

SECTION 2:

Payment for said electric energy shall be made by said Village in accordance with the terms of said specifications and in the amount specified in the accepted bid.

SECTION 3:

That the foregoing advertisement be made by the Village Clerk by posting notices for such bids in five (5) of the most public places in the Village, which five places are hereby determined to be as follows:

- One at Village Hall
 One at Post Office
 One at The Ottoville Bank Co.
 One at Kramer Barber Shop
 One at Dew Drop Inn

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
