

Ordinance No. 84

ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the application of Clarence Wessell and others for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Putnam and adjacent to the Village of Ottoville, to-wit:

Parcel 1

The West half Southeast quarter of the Southwest fractional quarter except the Northwest part of section 19, Monterey Township, Putnam County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of section 19, said point being 12.11 chains West of the South quarter post of section 19, thence N 0° 30' E along the East line of said parcel a distance of 19.8 chains, thence West a distance of forty links to the center of the Ottoville and Kalida Road, thence S 56° W along the center of the Ottoville and Kalida Road a distance of 14.9 chains, thence S 0° 30' W along the West line of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest fractional quarter a distance of 11.86 chains to the South line of section 19, thence East on the South line of said section a distance of 12.11 chains to the place of beginning.

Parcel 2

Commencing at the NW corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter thence East on the North line of said section, 341', thence South to the Center of the Kalida and Ottoville Road a distance of 312 feet, parallel with the center of East Street in Max Winkelman addition to Ottoville, thence Southwest along the center of said Kalida and Ottoville Road a distance of 415 feet, thence North on the West line of said Section line a distance of 527 feet to the place of beginning, less a strip 33 feet wide along the West line which was sold to the Delphos Northern Railroad Company.

Parcel 3

Beginning at a point where the Kalida Road intersects the North boundary line of said tract of land, running thence West along the said boundary line a distance of 218 feet, thence South a distance of 160 feet more or less to a point in the said Kalida Road 25 feet South of the North side of said Road, thence Northeasterly on a line parallel with the North side of said Road a distance of 268 feet more or less to a point from which a line drawn due North would strike the point of beginning, thence North a distance of 25 feet to the place of beginning.  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre.

Parcel 4

Commencing 341 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, Section 19, Monterey Township, running thence East on the North line of said Section a distance of 157 feet, thence South to the center of the Kalida Road a distance of 180 feet, thence Southwest along the center of the Kalida Road a distance of 201 feet, thence North a distance of 312 feet parallel with the center of East Street to the place of beginning.

Parcel 5

Commencing 13 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest fractional quarter of section 30 at the center of the Fort Jennings Road, thence East along the line of the said Northeast quarter a distance of 270 feet, thence Southwest a distance of 195 feet to the middle of the said Fort Jennings Road, thence Northwest in and along the center of said Road a distance of 195 feet to the place of beginning.

Parcel 6

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter; thence East on the North line of said section a distance of 33.0 feet; thence South to the center line of the Ottoville and Kalida Road; thence Southwest along the center line of said Road to the West line of said Section; thence North along the West line of said section a distance of 527.0 feet to the place of beginning.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for its annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the Clerk of said Village, he and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



## PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Commissioners of Putnam County, State of Ohio:

The undersigned, being a majority of the adult freeholders residing on the following described territory situated in the County of Putnam and adjacent to the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, towit:

### Parcel 1 Winklemans Subdivision

The West half Southeast quarter of the Southwest fractional quarter except the Northwest part of section 19, Monterey Township, Putnam County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of section 19, said point being 12.11 chains West of the South quarter post of section 19, thence N 0° 30' E along the East line of said parcel a distance of 19.8 chains, thence West a distance of forty links to the center of the Ottoville and Kalida Road, thence S 56° W along the center of the Ottoville and Kalida Road a distance of 14.39 chains, thence S 0° 30' W along the West line of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest fractional quarter a distance of 11.86 chains to the South line of section 19, thence East on the South line of said section a distance of 12.11 chains to the place of beginning.

### Parcel 2 Anton Klima

Commencing at the NW corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter thence East on the North line of said Section, 341', thence South to the Center of the Kalida and Ottoville Road a distance of 312 feet parallel with the center of East Street in Max Winkelman addition to Ottoville, thence Southwest along the center of said Kalida and Ottoville Road a distance of 415 feet, thence North on the West line of said Section line a distance of 527 feet to the place of beginning, less a strip 33 feet wide along the West line which was sold to the Delphos Northern Railroad Company.

### Parcel 3 Arthur Beining

Beginning at a point where the Kalida Road intersects the North boundary line of said tract of land, running thence West along the said boundary line a distance of 218 feet, thence South a distance of 160 feet more or less to a point in the said Kalida Road 25 feet South of the North side of said Road, thence Northeasterly on a line parallel with the North side of said Road a distance of 268 feet more or less to a point from which a line drawn due North would strike the point of beginning, thence North a distance of 25 feet to the place of beginning. ½ acre.

### Parcel 4 Alfred Ricker

Commencing 341 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, Section 19, Monterey Township, running thence East on the North line of said Section a distance of 157 feet, thence South to the center of the Kalida Road a distance of 180 feet, thence Southwest along the center of the Kalida Road a distance of 201 feet, thence North a distance of 312 feet parallel with the center of East Street to the place of beginning.

### Parcel 5 Eugene & Ruth Hoehn

Commencing 13 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest fractional quarter of section 30 at the center of the Fort Jennings Road, thence East along the line of the said Northeast

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quarter a distance of 270 feet, thence Southwest a distance of 195 feet to the middle of the said Fort Jennings Road, thence Northwest in and along the center of said Road a distance of 195 feet to the place of beginning.

Parcel 6 William Klima

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter; thence East on the North line of said section a distance of 33.0 feet; thence South to the center line of the Ottoville and Kalida Road; thence Southwest along the center line of said Road to the West line of said Section; thence North along the West line of said section a distance of 527.0 feet to the place of beginning.

An accurate map of which territory is hereto attached;

Respectfully petition that the said above described territory may be annexed to the Village of Ottoville. And Clarence Wessell is hereby authorized to act as agent of the petitioners in securing such annexation.
