ORDINANCE NO. 85

Accepting Application for Annexation of Territory.

BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the application of Walter Schlagbaum and Genevieve Schlagbaum for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Putnam and adjacent to the Village of Ottoville, to-wit:

Being a part of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Monterey Township, Putnam County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the South Quarter Post of Section 19, thence West along the Section line 799.0 feet, thence North 0 degrees 47 minutes, East 1307.46 feet, thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes, East 263.0 feet, thence South 0 degrees 47 minutes, West 1177.66 feet, thence East and parallel with the Section line 536.0 feet, thence South 0 degrees 46 minutes, West 130.0 feet to the place of beginning.
