## ORDINANCE NO. 131 - A

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS FOR MUTUAL POLICE AID.

WHEREAS, Section 737.04 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes any Village or City to enter into contracts, not to exceed three (3) years, with other political subdivisions to obtain police protection in times of emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, is desirous of entering into such an agreement with other political subdivisions who evidence the same desire;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION ONE: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with other political subdivisions for the purpose of obtaining mutual police aid in times of emergency.

SECTION TWO: The contract authorized to be entered into and the terms thereof has been carefully examined by Council, has been found satisfactory, and is made a part hereof by reference, the same as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in that the public safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, require the immediate passage of this ordinance to provide adequate police protection within said village and shall go into full force and effect immediately.
