## ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION ON APPLICATION OF FREEHOLDERS

To accept the application for the annexation of certain territory containing 12,05 acres in Monterey Township to the Village of Ottoville.
WHEREAS, a petition for the annexation of certain territory in Monterey Township was duly filed by Raymond A. Wannemacher and
WHEREAS, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio, on <u>September 9th</u> , 19 77, and
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of said territory to the Village of Ottoville as hereinafter described, and
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with said annexation with the map to the Village Clerk who received same on Sept. 13, 1977, and
WHEREAS, sixty days from the date of said filing has now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of R.C. $709.04$ ; now, therefore,
Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Ottoville:
1. That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition of Raymond A. Wannemacher and a majority of the owners of the land sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio, on July 5th, 19 77, and which said petition prayed for annexation to the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, of certain territory adjacent thereto as hereinafter described, and which said petition was approved for annexation to the Village of Ottoville by the Board of County Commissioners on September 9th, 1977, be and the same is hereby accepted. See Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof for description to said territory.
The certified transcript of the proceedings for annexation with an accurate map of said territory, together with other papers relating to the proceedings thereto of said County Commissioners are all on file with the Clerk of this Village Council and have been for more than sixty days.
2. That the Village Clerk be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to make two copies of this ordinance to each of which shall be attached a copy of the map accompanying the petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto and a certificate as to the correctnes thereof. The Village Clerk shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the County Recorder and one copy to the Secretary of State and do all things required by law.

Ray Wannamacher Sub-Division of 400.0 feet in equal width oif of the South em of the Southeast Quarter of the Mortheast Quarter of Section 25. 1. The owners herein reserves the right to construct all residential buildings upon all parcels. All grantees must secure

a written waiver from the owner for constanction by themselves or other persons.

SCHEDULE A

2. All homes constructed on any of the parcels must align with the same setback of previously constructed homes.

2. No buildings may be constructed in addition to the home in excess of 120 square feet.

4. All homes started must be completed within one (1) year from the date construction commences.

5. All parcels must be maintained by the grantee's thereof even though no building is located thereon, including but not limited to, the mowing of weeds.

3. No junk cars, boars or other items of little value or use may be stored upon the premises so as to create an unsightly condition or nuisance.
