

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO TAKACS EXCAVATING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio did authorize and direct its Mayor to execute a Contract with Takacs Excavating to construct Storm Sewer Improvements and said contract is dated May 4, 1984.

WHEREAS, certain changes are detailed in Change Order No. 1 resulting in an increase of \$636.80 to the contract amount;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Change Order No. 1 on behalf of the Village.

Section 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, since certain items of construction noted in Change Order No. 1 are necessary to maintain proper drainage and to allow future access to the system for maintenance, and as such this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
