ORDINANCE NO. 233

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VILLAGE HEALTH CARE FUND AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 226.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, a majority of its members concurring hereto that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a Health Care Fund to offset deductible and health care expenses for full-time employees and their dependants who elect to take health care medical coverage through the Village, effective August 1, 1989.

SECTION 2. The benefit year shall coincide with the policy benefit year. The maximum out-of-pocket medical expense for each full-time employee and their spouse and dependants, if participating in the plan, shall be a total of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each benefit year. The balance shall be paid from the fund hereby established. All funds presently existing in the Health Care fund established by Ordinance No. 226 shall be, and are hereby, transferred to the Health Care Fund hereby established.

SECTION 3. The Finance Committee shall review the medical bills of the employees and their dependants if covered under the Village Medical Plan on a monthly basis.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 226 passed June 26, 1990 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest day allowed by law.
