AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 243.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, a majority of its members concurring hereto:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 243 which reads:

SECTION 3. Each full-time employee shall be provided with the option of electing not to have health insurance coverage by the Village after the first day of the first month after the effective date of this ordinance. Those employees electing not to be covered shall be paid the sum of \$50.00 per month for each full month of non-coverage beginning with the first full month after the election of non-coverage is made. In order for an employee to elect non-coverage, he must provide the Village with proof that he has other health insurance coverage. Thereafter each employee must inform the Clerk-Treasurer of his election for coverage or non-coverage during the month of December each year unless a change in the employee's family status has occurred. A "change in family status" occurs when there is a marriage, divorce, gain or loss of a dependent, or an involuntary change in the employee's spouse's employment. In such case the employee shall notify the Clerk-Treasurer within 31 days in order to be eligible to make a new election.

shall be amended to read:

SECTION 3. Each full-time employee shall be provided with the option of electing not to have health insurance coverage by the Village after the first day of the first month after the effective date of this ordinance. Those employees electing not to be covered shall be paid the sum of \$100.00 per month for each full month of non-coverage beginning with the first full month after the election of non-coverage is made. Said payment, at the option of the employee, may be paid in equal installments along with the employee's regular pay, or may be paid as deferred compensation under the plan adopted by the State of Ohio. Said election by the employee may be made not more than once in any calendar year. In order for an employee to

elect non-coverage, he must provide the Village with proof that he has other health insurance coverage. Thereafter each employee must inform the Clerk-Treasurer of his election for coverage or non-coverage during the month of December each year unless a change in the employee's family status has occurred. A "change in family status" occurs when there is a marriage, divorce, gain or loss of a dependent, or an involuntary change in the employee's spouse's employment. In such case the employee shall notify the Clerk-Treasurer within 31 days in order to be eligible to make a new election.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
