

ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PRICE WHICH WEST OHIO GAS COMPANY MAY CHARGE FOR FURNISHING GAS SERVICE TO CONSUMERS IN THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO FOR AND DURING THE PERIOD SPECIFIED HEREIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring:

Section 1. RATE SCHEDULE

For the effective period of this ordinance and subject to modification as hereinafter provided, the rates to be charged to consumers within the corporate limits of the Village of Ottoville by West Ohio Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "Company"), for natural or equivalent gas furnished to such consumers by said company, shall be as follows:

- (a) The rates determined pursuant to the Company's tariffs on file with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, namely, P.U.C.O. Nos. 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 200 and 300, copies of which are attached hereto and specifically adopted and incorporated herein by reference, as the same may be amended or modified from time to time in filings made to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; PLUS
- (b) An additional charge of one dollar (\$1.00) per thousand cubic feet for all gas consumed from the effective date of this ordinance through December 31, 2000.

Section 2. GAS TARIFF ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

The Company's Gas Tariff filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio is hereby specifically adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE

This Ordinance and the rates which may from time to time be established under the terms hereof shall become effective December 4, 1995, or on the earliest date thereafter permitted by law and shall be and remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2000, and for successive periods of one (1) year each thereafter, unless the Village of Ottoville or the Company

shall give the other notice in writing of its intention to modify or amend any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the original term of this ordinance or of any subsequent year.

In the event any such notice is given and agreement on the proposed modification or amendment is not reached by the parties within said sixty (60) day period, this ordinance shall cease to be effective as of the first day of the year following the giving of such notice.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health and safety of the citizens of Ottoville, Ohio and shall therefore be effective upon passage.
