

ORDINANCE NO. 281

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 273  
WHICH ESTABLISHED AN AUXILIARY POLICE UNIT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville,  
a majority of its members concurring that:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 273 which reads as  
follows:

Section 2. The auxiliary police unit created by  
Section 1 hereof shall not exceed three members in number.  
All appointments to and removals from the auxiliary police  
unit shall be made by the Mayor, subject to the consent of  
Council. All applications for appointment to the auxiliary  
police unit shall be reviewed and approved by the Chief of  
Police, the Mayor, and Council. Any application by any  
person seeking appointment to the auxiliary police unit  
which is disapproved by the Chief of Police, the Mayor, or  
Council shall not be approved. Compensation of the members  
of the auxiliary police unit shall be established by  
resolution of Council.

shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The auxiliary police unit created by  
Section 1 hereof shall not exceed three paid members and  
eight non-paid members. All appointments to and removals  
from the auxiliary police unit shall be made by the Mayor,  
subject to the consent of Council. All applications for  
appointment to the auxiliary police unit shall be reviewed  
and approved by the Chief of Police, the Mayor, and  
Council. Any application by any person seeking appointment  
to the auxiliary police unit which is disapproved by the  
Chief of Police, the Mayor, or Council shall not be  
approved. Compensation of the members of the auxiliary  
police unit shall be established by resolution of Council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective at the  
earliest date allowed by law.
