ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION ON APPLICATION OF FREEHOLDERS. (KNOWN AS MILLER ESTATES 2)

To accept the application for the annexation of certain territory containing 5.796 acres, more or less, in Monterey Township to the Village of Ottoville.

WHEREAS, a Petition for the annexation of certain territory in Monterey Township was duly filed by Dennis Miller, and


