ORDINANCE NO. <u>06-04</u>

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRUCK PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO, OR THREE-FOURTHS OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING THERETO, THAT:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing a Class A truck, Class B truck, semi-tractor, semi-trailer, or dump truck upon the streets and alleys of the Village of Ottoville, Ohio, for more than 15 minutes except where the truck is disabled while on the streets and alleys of said Village of Ottoville or where the truck is being loaded or unloaded or a work site involving the use of the truck.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to park campers, recreational vehicles, vendor's trailers, flatbed trailers, and box trailers for more than 48 hours on village streets. It will be considered a violation of this ordinance to merely move any restricted vehicle from one parking spot to another, in an attempt to avoid the restrictions of this ordinance. It will also be considered a violation of this ordinance to temporarily remove a restricted vehicle and then return it to park on Village streets.

SECTION 3. Exceptions may be granted in designated industrial areas.

SECTION 4. Any person violating of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for a first offense and for the second and subsequent convictions within one year thereafter by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 294 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
