ORDINANCE NO. <u>2012-02</u>

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO, TO CHANGE STREET ADDRESSES AND STREET NAMES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the Village of Ottoville that the street addresses and street names within the Village lack uniformity; and;

WHEREAS, uniformity in street addresses and street names is a necessity to promote community safety for 911, police, and fire personnel to locate residents in emergency situations, and for postal and package delivery; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Council of the Village of Ottoville to put in place uniform standards for assigning street addresses and street names and to regulate the assignment of addresses within the Village, specifically using odd numbers on the West and South side of the roads and even numbers on the East and North side of the roads, when possible; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Council of the Village of Ottoville to have street addresses to be assigned so that West Canal Street divides the East and West streets and that Third Street divides the North and South streets and that the first block to East or West/North or South is "100 block" of East, West, North, or South; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the Village of Ottoville to have the name of Clay Street changed to Church Street and the current Clay Street addresses to be changed to having the address of Church Street; the name of Franklin Street to be changed to West Canal Street and the Franklin Street addresses to be changed to having the address of West Canal Street; and the name of Cherry Street to be changed to Fourth Street and the Cherry Street addresses to be changed to having the address of Fourth Street; and the name of Miller Street changed to Monterey Street and the current Miller Street addresses to be changed to having the address of Monterey Street; and to have the name of Kalida Avenue changed to Main Street and the current Kalida Avenue addresses to be changed to having the address of Main Street.

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Council of the Village of Ottoville to assign new subdivision street addresses at the time of the platting of new subdivisions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, OR TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING THERETO THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Street addresses shall be assigned within the Village, specifically using odd numbers on the West and South side of the roads and even numbers on the East and North side of the roads, when possible.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Street addresses shall be assigned so that West Canal Street divides the East and West streets and that Third Street divides the North and South streets and that the first block to the East or West/North or South is "100 block" of East, West, North, or South.

SECTION 3. The name of Clay Street shall be changed to Church Street and the current Clay Street addresses shall be changed to having the address of Church Street; the name of Franklin Street shall be changed to West Canal Street and the Franklin Street addresses shall be changed to having the address of West Canal Street; and the name of Cherry Street shall be changed to Fourth Street and the Cherry Street addresses shall be changed to having the address of Fourth Street; the name of Miller Street shall be changed to Monterey Street and the current Miller Street addresses shall be changed to having the address of Monterey Street; The name of Kalida Avenue shall be changed to Main Street and the current Kalida Avenue addresses shall be changed to having the address of Main Street.

SECTION 4. New subdivision street addresses shall be assigned at the time of platting.
