

Preliminary Consent Legislation

Ordinance # 2017-09

County/Route/Section: ALL/PUT/VAN SR 66/189/190/697

The following is an ordinance enacted by the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the described project:

This project proposes to mill and pave asphalt on the following State Routes:

- SR 66 in Allen County from the south corporation limits of the City of Delphos at 10.49 to Fifth Street at 12.02 except for the portion from the intersection of Main Street and Suthoff Street at 11.3 to the CSX railroad at 11.66
- SR 190 in Allen County from the junction with Fifth Street at 0.47 to the Putnam County line at 1.41
- SR 697 in Allen County from the Van Wert County line at 0.00 to SR 66 at 0.04
- SR 66 in Putnam County from the Van Wert County line at 0.00 to US 224 at 2.46
- SR 189 in Putnam County from US 224 at 0.11 to Winkleman Street in Ottoville at 0.30
- SR 66 in Van Wert County from the Fifth Street at 0.47 to the Putnam County line at 4.37
- SR 697 in Van Wert County from the west corporation limits of the City of Delphos at 6.58 to the Allen County line at 7.27

The project also includes repair of the following bridge:

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- The bridge on SR 66 over US 30 in Van Wert County

WHEREAS, a portion of the described project is within the village corporation limits.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Ottoville of Putnam County, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

ODOT and FHWA shall assume and bear 100% of the necessary costs of the State's highway improvement project. In the event that the village requests certain features or appurtenances to be included within the State's highway improvement project's design and construction, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State to be not necessary for the State's project, the village shall contribute 100% of the cost of those items.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required (if applicable) for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodations, relocations and reimbursements will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said Village of Ottoville is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Ottoville to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
