## **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-01**

## A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK FROM SUNSET DRIVE TO MONTEREY STREET

WHEREAS, the Village has determined it is necessary for the safety and welfare of its residents to install a sidewalk along the west side of SR 66 from Sunset Drive to Monterey Street, Ottoville; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalk construction cost will be paid for 70% by the property owners along/on their property on the west side of SR 66 and 30% by the Village pursuant to Ordinance 250; and

WHEREAS, the Village shall pay for any necessary modifications from the required sidewalk specifications as indicated in Ordinance 250; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to accept a quote from J&M Excavating for \$24,368.00 to install said sidewalk, in the event property owners do not comply within 60 days of notice, or another reasonable agreed upon time; and

WHEREAS, Council members will prepare a letter, and along with this Resolution, deliver or have it delivered to said property owners as required notice, pursuant to Ordinance 250.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTOVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, or two-thirds (2/3) concurring thereto:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> The Street Commissioner and/or the Sidewalk Committee is hereby authorized to proceed to provide notice or have notice provided to property owners of the required construction of a sidewalk along the west side of SR 66 from Sunset Drive to Monterey Street, Ottoville, pursuant to Ordinance 250.

SECTION 2: The sidewalk construction cost will be paid for 70% by the property owners along/on their property on the west side of SR 66 and 30% by the Village pursuant to Ordinance 250. The Village shall pay for any necessary modifications from the required sidewalk specifications as indicated in Ordinance 250. The Village has accepted a quote from J&M Excavating for \$24,368.00 to install said sidewalk, in the event property owners do not comply within 60 days of notice, or another reasonable agreed upon time.
