TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION

The Council of the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County Ohio met in regular session on the 19th day of December 2022, at the Ottoville Municipal Center with the following members present: Dan Honigford, Adria Petrick, Charlie Buss, Joseph Moreno, Julie Brickner, and William Miller.

Mr. Miller moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

A Resolution to make temporary appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of Ottoville, State of Ohio, during the first quarter of the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Ottoville during the first quarter of the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023, the following sums be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year, as follows, viz:

GENERAL	\$ 20,000.00
STREET CONSTRUCTION	20,000.00
WATER	20,000.00
SEWER	<u>20,000.00</u>
Total Annual Appropriations	\$ 80,000.00

Mr. Moreno seconded the Resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as all approved.

This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force forthwith, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to the Village council; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
