A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2023-04

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

Rev. Code, Sec. 5705.19, .191, .194, .21, .26

The Council of the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio met in special session on the 15th day of June 2023 at the office of Ottoville Municipal Center with the following members present:

Ms. Julie Brickner

moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Ottoville, Putnam County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Village of Ottoville for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the Village (Ohio Revised Code 5705.19 G), that the county auditor estimates will collect \$53,000.00 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.95 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$68.00 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for the duplicate years 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, and which levy is a replacement of an existing levy, commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.

RESOLVED, That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Ottoville at the General election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Ottoville on the 7th day of November 2023, and be it further

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Council of the Village of Ottoville be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Putnam County, Ohio, at least 75 days prior to the General Election and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

Mrs. Adria Petrick seconded the Motion and the roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows:

This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to the Village Council.
